I. Call to order

There must be a quorum of both Planning Commission and Borough Council members. Pam will confirm this with Borough Council at its workshop meeting on April 27, 2017. Cumberland County Planning has recommended the proposed ordinances be approved as submitted. Chief Day is prepared to do the necessary postings and mailings that are required.

A resident has expressed interest in the property at 113 E Pine Street. Currently, it is listed on the Cumberland County Registry of Historical Properties as 111 E Pine Street. The county is correcting the error.

A brief discussion of how to approach the SALDO process brought a recommendation from Mark Allshouse to find a model SALDO and modify it. The county should have one or we could look at one from a similar smaller municipality, such as, Dillsburg. Pam Still will check with the county.

Pam Still mentioned a Short-Term Rental meeting held by Cumberland County. The county is asking if municipalities are having issues with short-term rentals, such as, Airbnb.
