Public Comment: Joe Andreatti discussed Veteran's Park. He is back working on getting things started there. He has been in touch with Sherry at DCNR about grants and proper information needed there. Park cost – 60K for park and 10K for administrative costs and legal fees. There are no leans or questionable legal fees that need to be budgeted. Joe stated that he has been trying to get in touch with Sheaffers about the park for further discussion.

Old Business:

A: Veteran's Park – Clean-up has been set for Saturday, June 1st with CEFC. Joe Andreatti will coordinate with Pastor Dan from CEFC about this further. Joe stated that after the clean-up that maybe the Borough to do wood chipping of the brush. Deed search for Veteran's Park is good and the budget has been approved.

B: Concert In The Park – Saturday, June 15th at Trine Park from 4 to 7 PM with North Mountain Ramblers. In case of rain – it has been arranged with the firehouse to use their truck bay area. Posters were handed out to be distributed. Food was discussed: Ice cream – Dixie cups – Jim Brown, Brownies – Lois (Dickinson), Grill – Park and Rec will be purchasing one for their use, Soda – will be brought by Mt. Holly Beverage and delivered cold – 6 Pepsi, 4 Diet Pepsi, 4 Sierra Mist and 3-20 lb. bags of ice, Onions – chopped by Sue Fahnestock, 20 lbs. of BBQ – to be made by 5 lbs. each – Jean Smith, Barb Boise, Annan Hollinger and Sue Fahnestock, Hot Dogs – Cathy will talk to Sheetz about donation – decided on 100, Rolls – Cathy Neff, Donation Jar and table cover – Lois Stoner, Crock Pots/Wamer – Karen Bream, Plates, Napkins, Spoons – Karen Bream and Mustard, Ketchup and Relish – Sue Fahnestock. It was unsure if Jim Hoerner will be bringing sausages and rolls, but he will be asked. Wanda Showers did give word that the



Cumberland Valley Classic Car Club will be there – if not raining. Cathy Neff will be responsible for letting everyone know of the location change in case of rain.

C: Holly Festival – Saturday, September 21, 2019. There was confirmation of 35 vendors so far. There was discussion about advertising for vendors in The Guide twice to drum up more interest and get the word out. Also on Borough website – vendor information and applications. Also going to contact radio stations for advertising and entertainment – Randy DJ.

D: Halloween Parade – Next meeting with volunteers in July – meeting will be set at June Park & Recreation meeting. Also discussion about street closures and permits. Also discussion about Fire Police and the need for at least 8 on night of the parade.

E: There was discussion that the Clean-Up held on May 4, 2019 was very successful.

F: It was revealed that Joshua Dorand was hired by the Borough to do the mowing this summer. It was brought up by Jim Brown about having the benches placed in the parks. This will be mentioned to the maintenance crew.

G: Trine Park bathrooms fix cost \$450/\$500 more than expected . . . but will be ready for Memorial Day weekend.

H: Lois Stoner brought up that it was brought to her attention by Jim Hoerner that there will be no more parking allowed on the grass area off Butler Street and Borough complex for any events – including Fire Company Fair and Borough Holly Festival Day.

New Business:

1. It was brought up by Lois Stoner that she was approached by Jodie Fritz about having a Community Yard Sale at Stoll Field to benefit Furry Friends. She wanted to do this sometime in June. It was suggested that maybe they wait until the Community Yard Sale in July. More discussion will be needed at June meeting. It was also brought up about liability issues.
2. Annan Hollinger brought up about the flower planters at Butler Street and Trine Park – that they NOT be planted this year. Maybe be treated with weed killer this year and plan on planting small shrubs or perennials next year.
