



ALL MOUNT HOLLY SPRINGS RESIDENTS:

As you may or may not know, Advanced Disposal Services will again be handling your trash and recycling services effective 1/1/19. The Borough has awarded a contract which now supplies wheeled carts for both trash and recycling. Carts will be delivered to your residence before the end of the year. Each resident will receive a 96-gallon cart for trash and a 32-gallon cart for recycling. You may use the carts immediately. In an effort to make this transition as smooth as possible, we would like you to refer to this fact sheet for any questions that you may have. Your current scheduled trash days will not change with the new contract. Both Trash and Recycling will be collected on Monday of each week. Collections will begin from 6am to 7pm each Monday. Please have your trash curbside on the evening prior to pickup. Recycling will be picked up every week with the first pick up starting on January 7, 2019. Recycling will be collected in a single stream fashion as currently collected. We will not accept window glass, mirrors, plastic grocery bags, Styrofoam of any kind, ceramics, pizza boxes or shredded paper. Recyclable containers must be rinsed prior to placing in cart. Please see what materials can be accepted below as glass is no longer accepted.

- Aluminum cans
- Glass bottles and jars
- Plastics #1-7
- Junk Mail
- Phone Books
- Cardboard

- Paperboard boxes

During Holiday weeks, your trash will be collected on the day after the holiday, if the holiday falls on a week day. Should the holiday fall on a Saturday or Sunday, there will be no interruption in service and your trash will be collected on its regularly scheduled day. The following holidays will be observed:

- New Years Day
- Memorial Day
- Independence Day (July 4th)
- Labor Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas

Advanced Disposal Services will supply the exact service that you have had in the past. Included in your pickup is normal household trash and bulk items such as sofas, chairs, or mattresses. Appliances containing Freon like a refrigerator, freezer or air conditions cannot be accepted unless the refrigerant has been removed by a certified technician and properly stickered as such. Tires will not be accepted. No electronic devices will be accepted. Also tree limbs or wood bundles should be tied, not to exceed 3 feet in length or 14 inches in diameter.
