

## Parks & Rec Committee Meeting

June 18, 2019

**Attendance:** Cathy Neff, Lois Stoner, Jean Smith, Karen Bream, Curt Bream, Barbara Boise. **Public Attendance:** Rachel Bear, Brigitte Mountz, Jody Fritz, Jennifer Kennedy, Betsy German.

**Call to order:** Cathy Neff called the meeting to order at approximately 6:30pm

Motion made to approve minutes by: Lois Stoner – Motion was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jean Smith – All in favor

**Public Comments:** Jody Fritz discussed using Stoll field on July 20<sup>th</sup> for a community yard sale at \$5.00 per space. She will collect the fee and submit to Parks and Rec. The issue is that when the community yard sale occurs, the majority of the yard sales are in the main part of town (i.e., Baltimore Ave. and Chestnut St.). There is not much going on in the Mill Street area of town and this would allow that to occur. The yard sale is, however, open to anyone in the Mt. Holly Springs community, or outside.

### Old Business:

1. Veteran's Park – Cleanup that occurred on June 1<sup>st</sup> in conjunction with Carlisle Evan. Free Church was successful. Joe Andreatti is handling the DCNR grant paperwork. Cathy to follow-up on what is needed with respect to the county grant.
2. Concert in the Park – June 15<sup>th</sup> – North Mountain Ramblers – successful event – brought in \$590.00 and roughly 85 attendees. Cost of entertainment was \$500.00, and food was donated, therefore, a \$90.00 surplus was realized and given to Parks & Rec.
3. Holly Festival
  - a. Cathy Neff reported that she spoke with and confirmed DJ Randy Freed from 102.9 from 9:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. for \$400.00.
  - b. Trolley?...it was indicated that we would know by July 8<sup>th</sup> if a trolley from Penn Township is available for use in transporting folks from downtown to Trine Park and visa versa.
  - c. Bounce House – Lois was to contact Shev from CEFC to see if this was something they were still interested in and if they would be providing insurance and where it would be set up.
  - d. Question was asked to Jim Hoerner (via Bridgit Mountz), if the 'bicycle guy' (guy who collects old bikes and fixes them cheap and donates to needy kids) would be in attendance at the festival. It is Jim's understanding that he will be and will be set up at the firehouse that day.
4. Halloween Parade – next meeting will be on 7/14 at 1pm at the Three Pines to discuss coordination

### New Business:

1. Resignation letters were submitted by Susan Fahnestock and Wanda Showers. These will be presented to the July Borough council. Two individuals are interested in becoming part of the committee – Gay Bowman and Betsy German. These folks will be voted upon during the July Parks and Rec committee meeting on 7/16.
